### **Potato Pests and Diseases**

#### **Leaf Miners**



The larvae of Leaf Miners make tunnels through the leaves. You can see the white lines. This damage means the leaves cannot make enough food for the plant to grow well.

To treat, mix 10ml of *Vapcomic* with 20L of water in a knapsack. Spray when you see lines on the leaves from Leaf Miners.



### **Early and Late Blight**



Blight is caused by a fungus which affects the leaves of your potato plants. The leaves look brown and burnt. The disease can spead very fast. Blight is more common when the weather is cold and wet.

Prevent Blight with *Oshothane Plus*. Mix 50g of *Oshothane Plus* with 20L of water in a knapsack. Spray the leaves when the crop is 4-6 inches tall. Spray every 7-10 days.

**Cure** Blight with *Mistress 72*. Mix 40g *Mistress 72* in 20L of water in a knapsack. Spray when you see signs of Blight. If it is raining heavily, spray every 2 weeks.





### Get a better potato crop with Oshozyme



**Oshozyme** is a bio-fertilizer that you can spray on the seeds before planting. It helps the crop's roots to better use nutrients and water to grow well. You will get a big yield of large potatoes.

Spray seeds on a mat or canvas on the ground in the shade. Mix 40ml *Oshozyme* with 1L of water. Spray the seeds evenly. Let the seeds dry for 30 minutes before planting.



## **Getting a Good Heifer**

Your heifer should put on 500-800g per day. When it is ready for service it will be 280-300kg. Your cow should be ready for service after 15 months so it calves down by 24 months. The sooner your heifer can be served, the sooner you will get milk that you can sell.

## Feeding your heifer

#### **Young Stock Pencils**



After weaning at 8-10 weeks, give your heifer 0.5kg of **Young Stock Pencils** every day. Increase the amount over time. By 8 months, your heifer should be eating 1.5kg per day.

#### KupaKula Gold



Mix 5kg of KupaKula Gold into 50kg of Young Stock Pencils. This will give your heifer extra Protein.


#### **Maclik Plus**




Mix 100g of Maclik Plus into the **Young Stock Pencils** every day. It contains minerals. It will help your heifer to come on heat at the right time and to get pregnant.

### Build a good clean cow shed

Make sure your heifer has fresh drinking water at all times.






A sloping mabati roof allows you to catch rain water to give to vour heifer.

A cement floor is easy to clean. Clean the cow shed every day for a healthy heifer. Slope the floor for good drainage.

## **Choosing a bull**

You will get a better calf if you choose a bull from the **Coopers CRV catalogue** and get a vet to do Artificial Insemination (AI). Choose a bull based on the characteristics that you would like in your calf, such as:



- High milk production
- Well-formed body
- Comes on heat early Calves easily
- Milks quickly.

You must choose your bull before your cow comes on heat. Once your cow is on heat you only have 12-18 hours for the vet to come and do AI.



Look at your cow's udder. Is it too high? Too low? The best is number 3 in the picture. If the udder is too low, choose a bull that will give a calf with a high udder.

## **Feeding Calves**

## From day 1 to day 3

The first milk the mother makes is called **colostrum**. It is very good for the calf.

Allow the calf to suckle from the mother whenever it likes for the first 24 hours after birth. At the end of the second day it can be taken away from the mother. For the next 3 days, give the calf 6L of colostrum per



## From day 4 to weaning (9 weeks)

Give the calf *Sprayfo*. This is a calf milk replacer. A litre of *Sprayfo* costs much less than a litre of milk. By using **Sprayfo** you can continue to sell milk and make more money. **Sprayfo** is made from milk by-products and oil. It helps the calf to grow fast.





Mix 300g of *Sprayfo* with 2L of warm water.



Feed your calf 2 litres of *Sprayfo* 3 times a day.



If the calf feeds with its head down, If the calf feeds with its head facing Use a teat bucket to make sure the milk goes into its first stomach. upwards, the milk goes straight This can cause diarrhoea.



to the back stomach. This is much better for the calf.



the calf feeds with its head facing upwards. Hang the bucket just above the calf's head.

## From 3 weeks to weaning (9 weeks)

As well as Sprayfo, start giving your calf Early Weaner Pellets.



Start at 3 weeks on 0.5kg of *Early Weaner Pellets* per day. Increase the amount over time. By weaning at 9 weeks, your calf should be eating 1.5kg of Early Weaner Pellets per day.

Feed straw to your calf. Straw helps the stomach to expand.

Always make sure your calf has clean water to drink.

Raise the floor in your calf shed so that the calf does not sleep on manure. Keep the shed clean.

## Mitsubishi L200 Pick-up

The *Mitsubishi L200* pick-up from Simba Corp can help you transport your produce to market.

- Can carry up to 1 tonne of produce
- You can get a canopy to put on the back to protect your produce from wind and rain.
- Comfortable leather seats
- Single cabin
- 4 wheel drive and high ground clearance for rough roads.

The Mitsubishi L200 comes with a warranty of 3 years or 100,000 km, whichever is sooner.

It will not need a major service for 5 years. You can buy genuine spare parts at a good price from Simba Corp. There are **Simba Corp** branches countrywide.
